

2018 GROCERY BID ADDENDUM No.1

Original clause:

1.10: Split cases must be provided at the same per unit price as the full case price, even if the item is sold under a separate item description and code number.

Revision:

This clause is now deleted from the specifications in its entirety

Original clause:

10.3: The Vendor will have a Discount Program, which at a minimum, offers a 1% discount on invoices over \$1,000. Checks are to be sent to each district twice a year on January 15th and June 15th. Invoices for orders delivered to the same account, on the same day will be count as one order for rebate purposes.

Revision:

The 1% discount may be applied as a statement credit on or about the dates listed above.

Original clause:

4.1: Buy American: There are 2 situations in which an SFA may consider items of non-US origin:

- The product is not produced or manufactured in the U.S. in sufficient and reasonable available quantities of a satisfactory quality; and or
- Competitive bids reveal the costs of a U.S. product are significantly higher than the non-domestic product.

Revision:

The MSBG is requiring domestic product for each bid item, regardless of any higher cost over a similar imported item, unless a domestic product is not available in sufficient and reasonable quantities. In this case, the vendor is to complete the Buy American Exemption form for this item, and NOT select the “Domestic Product” check box for that line.

Original item:

MSBG Grocery Bid, line 71: Waffle Stick, WG, cinnamon, Belgian Chef 30089947002538

Revision:

This line is being eliminated from the bid. Please enter a “0” in the Price per case cell.
